 the P^r John Elzey, Randall Russell & Stephen Horsey or any
 Two of them, & being wth in this Province, take the Oath of
 fidelity by & p^r conditions of Plantation required. Wth p^r Oath
 the P^r John Elzey, Randall Russell, & Stephen Horsey, or
 any Two of them, are hereby impowred to administer, to
 all or any the persons desirous to transplant themselves as
 afores^d, before they shall have any Warr^{ts} granted unto
 them respectively. And also Provided that all such persons
 as shall have any warr^{ts} granted be accountable to y^e Secre-
 tary for y^e time being for all such fees, as for y^e P^r Warr^{ts}
 & Entries shall become due. And y^e P^r John Elzey, Randall
 Russell & Stephen Horsey, are hereby required to keepe a
 Booke of all such Rights & warr^{ts}, as shall bee by them
 or any of them granted, distinctly recyting the name &
 surname of every person for & in respect of whose warr^{ts}
 p^rortion they have allowed any Land. And the same att y^e
 end of the Three months afores^d to Returne into y^e Secre-
 taries office signed wth their hands. And for as much as in
 a place now peopled some differences may betwene y^e
 & y^e arise, or crimes be perpetrated & committed. For y^e
 Conservation of y^e Peace, & better Govern^t of y^e People there
 residing. Wee doe hereby empower the P^r John Elzey, Randall
 Russell & Stephen Horsey, or any Two of them to hear and
 determine all Causes not exceeding Two Thousand pounds
 of Tob. As also to cause to bee apprehended & punished
 any Criminalle offending agst any the Lawes of this Province
 Provided they proceed not to take life or member. Gi-
 ven att P^r Maner under the lesser Seale of this Province
 this 4th day of February, in the one & Thirtieth Yeare of
 his Maj^{ties} Dominion over y^e P^r Province. Anno Dⁿⁱ 1662.
