At Pascatoway 1st June 1663.

The Leut^t. Grate arriving at Pascatoway on y^e Thirtieth
day of May, according to Agreement wth y^e Indians, concerning
the Election of a new Emperour for that Nation (their
former Emper^r being dead), The next Day came the
Kings & Grecke men of all y^e Neighbouring Townes: who sat
in Councell about y^e Election. And having concluded
thereon on their parts.

They presented on y^e Day following, being the first Day of
June to y^e Hon^{ble} the Leut^t. Grate, a young youth named
Narrowaw^o, about eleven yeares of age (This youth being
the eldest Sonne of Wabocaw^o late Emper^r of Pascatoway
deceased) to bee their Emper^r. And requested y^e Leut^t to
approve of their Election, & to confirme y^e Narrowaw^o
Emper^r of Pascatoway.

Their Reasons why they made choice of this youth to bee
Emper^r are these: Declaring how y^e on his past t^h
were living at Pascatoway Two families; out of w^{ch} Two
families, their Kings were chosen. The one being y^e of
Wannys, The other y^e of Wabocaw^o. of w^{ch} w^{as}
caw^o this Narrowaw^o deceased, hee being his eldest so
as afore^s.

Further the Indians shew, That there is a Daughter y^e
family of Wannys, now living at Pascatoway, & about the
same age, wth this youth now elected by them. To w^{ch} your.
