

These are the names of the Indians who are to go by the house of Jacob (Carter) & Symon Carpenter, & there be delivered to Quilley & the rest of the Sasquehannock Indians Two Barrels of powder, & Two hundred weight of Lead & afterwards are to go by the house of Mr. Nathaniel Vye along with the Indians, & there present any one of the Three guns. And let it be delivered to the Indians: of which guns the Indians are to have their choice. All particulars being for the public like use. & for seeing this shall be your work. Given under my hand at Goldsmiths hall 28 July 1663.

To Capt. Thomas Stockett.

At a Council held at Goldsmiths Hall the 9<sup>th</sup> of August. 1663.
