to the more speed
& effectual suppression of all murders, robberies
& infractions, murders or plundering & may be
committed by any Indian or Indians whatsoever.

1. That you are hereby empowered to give notice or
approach of any Indians whatsoever to any English
Plantation in this Province to any what force
you & your servants shall think convenient for
resistance of any infractions or murders by
them committed, or may be intended to be com-
mitted upon your persons or Estates, of any of the
Inhabitants of this Province as aforesaid.

2. That you are to empower such & such persons as you shall
think fit with you & your servants to give
such instructions as shall be from time
to time by you to them directed.

3. That you do call to your assistance the County Court
as time & opportunity shall require & permit to
consult & advise upon what is expedient upon
an urgent occasion to be done.

4. That you forthwith send to the Sagadahoc Indians
to give them notice if they immediately come down
to meet with you & your servants of this County
about the Articles of Peace lately confirmed by
you & Council together with their consent & assent
ally strictly to insist upon the Article (vizt) That
they shall not approach any English Plantation, but
according to the tenor of that Article.
