house. - Whether if James Golley refuse
to perform his Bargaine in repaying of
the house, according to his former promise
made to the Hon^r & Council: It bee not
thought convenient to lett the house for
certaine time of years to Willm Smith
for his better Encouragem^t. See putting in
specially to repay of same in convenient
time to bee limited by the Court. Grate.

Judged most fit, requisite, & convenient.
And then ordered for the Willm Smith
find a convenient place or Chamber for
the Clerk of the Court to lodge in, in the
house. - And of the house, to putt of the
caddis in, be quite finished, some convenient
rooms or places bee likewise allowed to be
used for the Records to bee kept in, & the
Clerks to write in.

Legally & whole Business touching the same
bee wholly left to the Court's discretion, ex-
cept as the Repaying of the house, or otherwise,
as to him shall seeme convenient, in agreeing
with the Smith. If bee see cause therefore
