sd James Golly to keep an Inne or Ordinary for
whole yeares next ensuing y^e date hereof, soe y^e
sd James Golly suffer not any evill Rule or Ord^r to bee
kept in his sd house during y^e tyme of this his sd License
For y^e using of which License accordingly I the sd
Charles Calvert doe you to witt That I have bound
y^e sd James Golly in one Thousand pounds of Tobacco
by Recognizance to y^e Lord Proprietary of this province
In witness whereof I have hereunto sett my hand
Seale this Twelveth day of May Anno dⁿⁱ Domini
one Thousand six hundred sixty fower
This Day came James Golly of St Marys County
acknowledged god himselfe indebted unto y^e Lord
Proprietary of this province in y^e sume of one
Thousand pounds of Tobacco & Cask in safe y^e
sd James Golly for y^e space of the whole yeares
next
