retayle or otherwise to any p^{er}son causing y^e disturbance of
his L^ops peace, Thus done at St Marys this seventh
day of May anno 1664

May it please yo^r L^op

SINCE our first Court hath been held for this County at
y^e house of M^r Francis Wright, where y^e Indian being a
game had, in some measure examined; nothing appearing to
any purpose, but what was have in y^e first given yo^r L^op to
the hands; yesterday when y^e prisoner was here, there was
several Asaschanago to y^e number of forty or two of
Circuliers vnkles who made show of much Joy at his
being taken, for they very well know him & were sensible
of his warlike exploits & would perswade us to have
burnt him but was Certifyed y^e that it was not y^e M^{rs}
to torture our prison, but y^e happy y^e he might be sent
home to his Country both for their good &c. but was
cannot find y^e what this prisoner did already in his own
behalf (as to matter of Beaver & peade which hee says
they brought wile they them to purchase peade) to be true,
Whether they had any they any good Intensions we
have done our utmost Endeav^r according to y^e ability
for y^e obloquing a full discovery, & p^{er}fect Relation
