Whereas by Reason of a late Inuasion of the
 Indians divers persons have been pressed out
 of your County to goe out for seed of some of
 the Province in generall whose Crops if not
 looked after will in a monthes time be utterly
 lost, And the Charge of the Province
 hereby become very greates w^{ch} we therefore
 in the name of the Right Hon^{ble} the King & People
 of the Province straightly Charge & Comanded
 to issue you warrants to the severall Constables
 within your County to take notice what persons
 have been pressed for this present Expedition
 and what Crops they have standing of Corn
 and Tobacco and what ground they have pro-
 pared for tobacco and the same be caused to
 be sowed and planted as the seasons do present
 and need shall require by the people of the
 neighbour hood for and during the term
 of six ^{weeks} monthes next after his departure of the
 or they shall be soe long out upon y^e service
 And this shall be your warrant given under my hand
 this 14th day of June 1665 -
