at St Marys y^e 25th of July 1665

It is then taken into consideration some speedy way for
y^e provision of y^e Incurfions made by y^e fresh roopers
of Inago Indians into this province

The debate whereof is left till to Morrow morning
where y^e same they doe ~~to~~ journe

July 26th
All present as before

Then ordered
That the soules now all ready raised be sent forth
with to Frontino, that is to say that the party do
drawne out of St. Marys Charles & Kent Countys be
sent into Baltimore County the 20 to settens that County
as well on y^e Eastern as on the western side of y^e
Bay to be Comanded by Col^l Lewis Stokett or some
other fitt person of an able body to endure the hardship
of the Woods being in that County to be Appoynted by
him

That the Comand^r do owne interest there may oblige them
to be diligent in Ranging the woods etc y^e intent they may
the easely find out this Skulking Enemy that sure
Commander shall have power to take their affiances any
number of frowne Indians they shall thinke fitt & to pro-
pound to them the reward of one hundred armes length
of Beards or the value thereof in Beads for every
prisoner they shall deliver alive or otherwise the same
rate for every Mann of the Enemye they shall Deli-
ver they being in his Right Law according to a former
Order of the Council

That the party raised in Calvert County do march into Anne
Arundell County to Capt^t Burgess & that he doe with the
party & his owne party raised in that County under
Banner
