Upon request made by John Nuttall Thomas Spring & Nic^h Young the
Hon^{ble} of John Nuttall late of the Cross in Anno Domini 1661 was taken
into Consideration the distributing of Estate & Personal of the said Dec^d:

Ordered that the same be divided equally amongst the three
Children (viz) John James and Eleanor Nuttall now wife to the
aforesaid Thomas Spring, and that Security be given by each person
that what debts or Claims should be truly made by any
person out and from the said Estate hereafter shall be satisfied
out of each persons part or portion he allotted them

Further ordered that on Monday next the said Nuttall Estate be gathered
and brought together that review may be made thereof and equally
divided as aforesaid

The Council having likewise taken into their Consideration
what shall be done wth the Soldiers now remaining in arms -
Upon which is ordered that they be forthwith disbanded
and withdrawn

The Council doth now proceed to the making up of the public
Levy for this present year of 1664
