

It is likewise thought convenient and so ordered  
that there be a trade maintained and held by the English  
with the Eastern Shore Indians —

Upon the petition of Charles De La Roche Roberts  
waterman Andrew Mearns and Henry Lincoln late  
soldiers in the last Expedition of the Indians that  
they be ordered there pay in the next publick pay  
Further ordered that it be Certified unto the Colonells  
hands unto the Troopers in the said that were out  
in the aforesaid Expedition that they have their  
pay likewise in the next publick pay and that  
Capt Philemon Coy do Certify in a list w<sup>th</sup> that  
were the names of such Troopers as were under his  
or any other persons Command in the said war —

Further ordered that what persons should  
that shall build any howsing of any the Land  
ordained for Towns within this Province shall  
have builded times the quantity of Land allotted  
to him or them that every such Town shall stand  
upon and that Smiths Creek in Charles County  
shall be one of the places nominated for appointing  
for a Town and that some other place to be  
pitched upon by Governor White by the Surveyor  
General shall be ordained for another Town  
in Portobaco in the said County and that the  
said Surveyor General do Certify what place is  
for pitched upon by him to the Justices at the  
next Provincial Court that the same may be  
inserted in a more publick Proclamation then to  
issue for the removing of all laws appointed  
within this Province for the building & ordering  
of Towns within each County there being some  
These places nominated since the last Proclamation  
issued at the last Provincial Court —
