 of Maryland And Doe further give us Our
 and Successors straightly enjoyn Constituted Order
 and Command that the said Peter Mill in all things
 be well treated reputed & esteemed as one of the
 faithful people of Our Kingdom & Successors be
 within the Our said province of Maryland & like
 any lands tenement Revenues Services Other
 Privileges whatsoever within Our said province
 of Maryland may Inherit Our Other wife and
 receive take hold buy and possess the
 may Occupy and enjoy Give free Alien & bequeath
 as likewise all Liberties franchises & privileges
 of this Our province of Maryland freely give
 and purchase hold and possess Occupy and
 enjoy as Our faithful people borne Or to be
 borne within Our said province of Maryland
 without the least Molestation Oppression trouble
 or grievance of us Our heirs & Successors any
 Customs to the contrary hereof in any
 wise notwithstanding Given all Our Wills
 of st made under Our Great Seal of
 said province of Maryland this third and
 twentieth day of March in the xxvijth year
 of Our Dominion Over Our said province
