

good and valuable consideration as aforesaid shall hold & enjoy the same without any manner of violence disturbance or molestation as Goods Commodities and Merchandises sold in every market and that the Properties and Proprieties of such Goods Commodities and Merchandises so to be sold as aforesaid shall by such publick sale be actually and legally deemed and judged and taken to be and to be invested in the Buyer and purchaser of the same who shall so publickly buy and purchase the same any thing to the contrary in any wise notwithstanding and the said Lord Proprietary doth hereby further declare and Order that all and every Offender and Offenders against the true intent and meaning of this present Ordinance shall suffer one whole years Imprisonment and for ever after be incapable of claiming any new Grant or Grants of any Lands Tenements or Hereditaments from his said Lordship or his heirs within the said Province or any the Islands and places thereof belonging by virtue of any Conditions of Plantation to the contrary notwithstanding Given under the Great Seal of the said Province of Maryland the 20<sup>th</sup> day of April in the seventh and thirtieth Year of his Lordships Dominion over the said Province Anno Domini 1669 Witness Charles Calvert Esq<sup>r</sup> his Lordships Lieutenant General of the said Province of Maryland
