good and sufficient consideration as aforesaid shall hold & enjoy the same without any manner of disturbance or molestation at Goods Commodity and merchandise sold in said market and that the property and franchises of aforesaid Goods Commodity and Merchandise so to be sold and disposed of shall by such publick sale be lawfully and legally disseized and taken to be and to be invested in the Buyers and purchasers of the same who shall respectively buy and purchase the same anything contrary to the contrary may now notwithstanding and the said Lord Proprietor doth hereby further declare and Ordain that all and every Officer and Officer required the free intent and meaning of this present Ordinance shall suffer one whole year Improvement and forever after be incapable of claiming any new Grant or Grants of any Lands Tenements or hereditaments from his said Lordship or his Successors within the said Province, over the Islands and places there of belonging by virtue of any Conditions of Plantation to the contrary notwithstanding standing hereunder the Great Seal of the said Province of Maryland the 20th day of April in the second and Thirtieth Year of his Lordship's Government over the said Province Anno Domini 1669
