

Commission to the Deputy Lieutenant

To all whom these presents shall come the right
 Honourable Charles Lord Saye and Sele Knight of Saye
 and of Fulham by birth Baron and Lord Chief Governor and
 Lieutenant of the Province of Maryland in the parts of America
 and of all the Islands Territories and Possessions thereunto
 Belonging specially finding where as the said Lieutenant
 being now arrived in England in Obedience to the Commands
 of the said Lord Proprietor of this Province whose service
 may justly allege the said Lieutenant to be long and service
 from his Government and the actual Exercise of his Office there
 he could well perceive at his departure from the said Province
 by reason whereof it became necessary for him to give more
 particular powers and authorities than hitherto he hath done
 to the persons by him constituted his deputies for the exercise
 of his said Office and Government in his absence & to make
 some addition to the persons by him constituted and intended
 to be constituted deputies as before mentioned that by the absence
 or death of any of them there should happen fail or neglect in
 the execution of the said Office Heretofore yet that the said
 Lieutenant for the Considerations aforesaid and for and the
 Consideration of the particular trust and confidence which
 he hath in his ^{most} the Honorable Philip Calvert Esq^r then
 colonel of the said Province his dear citizen William Calvert Esq^r
 and his wife Bridget Lenn Whalley and Robert Brook
 his late mate constituted and retained and added by the said
 made constituted and chosen the said Chamberlain of Calvert
 from the said Robert Brook every three or four of them of which
 the said Chamberlain William Calvert of either of them shall
 be living and present within the said Province to be made
