

to his sufficient deputies and commissioners by him or his  
 officers appointed for the government of the said Province and  
 the due execution of all such authorities and by virtue  
 of any commission or commissions hereunto annexed <sup>or other</sup> given or  
 granted of his said Highness the said Lord and Captain by the Queen  
 his Reputacion of the said Lieutenant by whom he  
 was appointed or who appointed him may be or were  
 each having and by these presents granting unto his said  
 deputies and commissioners all such powers government and author  
 ities and jurisdictions which the said Lieutenant can or may  
 lawfully give or grant to any Deputy or Commissioner by him  
 or his officers appointed by virtue of any such  
 Commission granted or hereunto annexed of his said Lordship  
 as before and as shall be held exercised or executed by them the said  
 Chancellor William Culver, Jerome White and Butler Broke  
 any three or two of them of which the said Chancellor or the  
 Culver either of them shall be living or present within the  
 said Province, to be readying the absence of the said Lieutenant  
 from the said Province or about such time as the said Lieut  
 and shall think fit by any instrument under his hand and seal  
 to make these presents and the like written to be given and the  
 said Lieutenant doth likewise give and grant unto his said  
 Deputy or any three or two of them of which the said Chan  
 cellor or William Culver either of them shall be living and  
 present within the said Province as aresaid to be readying  
 the absence of the said Lieutenant and the continuance of the  
 Power and Authorities hereby given by themselves their  
 Captains ..... and Officers by them to be appointed  
 to levy martial law in all sorts of men of what condition  
 ever, and whatsoever be or will be within the said Province and  
 Territories for the time remaining and in case of Invasion  
 to be assaulted or approached by any enemy or enemies
