 upon hand within the said Province and Colonies or
 upon the Sea to exercise martial Law against all Rebels
 mutinous and seditious persons of those parts who shall re-
 fuse to submit themselves to his Majesty's Government,
 or to serve in the war or shall fly to the Enemy or forsake
 their Ensignes and to Discipline or Straglers or otherwise how-
 soever offending against the Law, Custom or discipline mil-
 itary as prescribed in a simple manner and form as any Capt
 General of any of the said Kingdoms or Navy by virtue of his
 Office might according to the Laws of the said Province do
 the same and further the said Law doth grant unto the
 said Captain General and Admirall of the said Province
 Chamberlain or William Culbert or either of them shall be li-
 vely and present in the said Province as aforesaid to be one
 full power and Authority during the Continuance of the War
 therewith by granted for and in the name of the said Lord
 and Proprietary as they shall think fitting from time to
 time to pardon, Remit or Release whether before Judgment
 or after all Offences against the Laws of the said Province and
 Colonies or any of them and also all and all manner of
 Grievances and wrongs incurred or to be incurred by
 any person or persons for or by reason of any Cause or Causes
 Offence or Offences committed or to be committed against any
 the Law, Custom or Orders of the said Province or any
 such pardon, Remission or Release do not or shall not extend
