and between nation of any rebellion. And we enjoin further  
upon land and sea the said Fleets and Commanders &  
upon the said officers named hereagainst all rebels  
malsters and adherents persons of those parts who shall be  
first to submit themselves to his Majestys Government.  
or to sue in the wars or shall fly to the enemy or forsake  
their Ensigns and be fighters in Standards otherwise how  
ever offending against the Law, Customs or discipline and  
harmes & injuries and in a sumptuous and sumptuary life  
General of all my & all admirals of a Navy by virtue of his  
Office and according to the laws of the said service do  
the same and further the said Law doth grant unto the  
said Admirals and Admirals of either of them shall be  
engaged and present in the said service unsatisfied to receive  
full power and authority during the continuance of the War  
hereafter by granted for and in the name of the said Lord  
and Proprietaries they shall think fitting from time to  
time to judge & render judgement whether before Judgment  
ever for all offenses against the laws of the said service and  
Customs & usage of them and also all and all manner of  
cognovit sum and shall be bound to be incurred by  
any person or persons for any damage done by him or them  
of whom ever offens or committed to be committed against any  
the said Officers and others of the said service so as no  
such damage done by them or them done or shall not be im-
