

Various touchy business relating to the Government  
 of the said Province and of the people there. Provided always  
 that the said deputies of them shall not have power  
 hereby nor shall these presents in any way therewithal  
 be construed deemed adjudged or taken to give any power  
 whatsoever to the said <sup>Representatives</sup> in any of their  
 several sessions or assemblies of the Freeman of the said  
 Province delegates of the Freeman of the said Province for the  
 giving of their advice and counsels <sup>by his said Shippe</sup> to be taken by the  
 said <sup>Representatives</sup> published within the said Province. Provided also  
 that each of the said deputies before he shall take upon him  
 the execution of any of the powers and authorities  
 hereby given or granted shall respectively take the Oath here  
 tofore annexed by the said Lieutenant to be taken by the  
 said Philip Calvert, Towne White and Baker Bwoke for  
 myself appointed <sup>Deputies</sup> of the said Lieutenant both by  
 said Lieutenant of the said Province of Maryland by Com  
 mission from me under the hand and Seal of the said  
 Lieutenant before his departure from the said Province the  
 same to be administered unto the said Chancellor by the  
 said William Calvert, Towne White and Baker Bwoke who  
 are hereby authorized to give and administer the same unto  
 the said Lieut who will minister to the said William Calvert,  
 Towne White and Baker Bwoke respectively which the  
 said Chancellor is hereby authorized to administer accordingly  
 and the said Lieutenant doth hereby recollect and make  
 valid certain commissions by him heretofore formerly given  
 unto the said Chancellor Towne White and Baker Bwoke  
 constituting appointing and ordering them his deputies of  
 the said Province and all and every former and other com  
 missions or commissions authority and authorities by him
