Highness the Duke of York was admitted of his Lordships Council
and

Ordered that Notice be given to him and Clerk of His
Majestys in the County of Middlesex appear at the next
General Court within the City of London of the said Court
and afterwards one of his Lordships Council

Ordered that all Land by the waterside and three miles
wide the river above Rotherhithe not surveyed be reserved
until his Highness shall be laid out for his Lordships use

Ordered that from the high hill to the degree forty
Northly Latitude be erected into a County called by the
name of Northam and from the high hill to the point
Lambeth be taken and erected into County and called as
the Lambethian County shall hereafter be called.

Ordered that Notice be given to the Sheriff of Somer-
set, Dorsetshire, Hertford & Middlesex Counties that what
you will and may Land on the Seaboard side and the
Lower Bay from the Bounds of Virginia to the degree forty
Northly Latitude shall forthwith recover and pay only one
Shilling per Acre and of whomsoever every fifty Acres which he
shall have shall take up upon his warrant and shall the
Subsequent day pay him per Acre as he shall think fit
to have the same paid him by himself or by his Factors
for his Lordships use in such County manner to be directed
as the said County shall be directed.

Ordered that the Surveyor General do make out the
Northly bounds of the said County as near as possible at the
Degree of forty and return the same to the Surveyor General
of his Council.

Ordered that Sir William Bache the Governor thereof
be desired to provide the necessary Ships, boats and vessels
to accommodate the Surveyor General up the Bay by the twenty-
