Ordered that Notice be given to Samuel Cheve of New
England in the County of Middlesex to appear at the next
Shirriffall Court to take the Oath of Justice of the said Court
and afterwards one of his Lordships Council

Ordered that all Land by the waterside and three miles
into the woods above Piscataway not surveyed be reserved
until ten thousand Acres be laid out for his Lordships use

Ordered that from the North hill to the degree forty
Northward Latitude be created into a County called by the
name of Wickham and from the North hill to Mount
Scarborough be likewise created into a County and called as
the Lord Proprietary shall hereafter direct

Ordered that Notice be given to the Sheriffs of Somers-
et Dorchester Shalbot & Baltimore Counties that what Per-
sons will suit on any Lands on the Seaboard side and Pe-
lican Bay from the Bounds of Virginia to the degree forty
Northward Latitude shall for their encouragement pay only one
Shilling Sterling and of Annals for every fifty Acres which he
or they shall take up upon Survey warrant and that the
Surveyor General do allow of some parcels as he shall think fit
to survey the same and lay out by several sides two thousand
for his Lordships use in each County and threescore
six thousand Acres a piece

Ordered that the Surveyor General do mark out the
Northward bounds of the several Colonies as far as possible at the
Degree of forty and return his Observations to the Surveyor
General

Ordered that Mr William Burch the Governor should
be desired to provide the Governor Heop with necessary vessels
to accommodate the Surveyor General up the Bay by the present
