Thirdly You are required to get the Records of the said Office

Hire and dues to myrdey mylly Mr. Thomas Holey to be
performed by the said Holey as he shall direct

Fourthly You are required to take the proof of all such rights
for land as shall be offered by any person demanding the profit of
his land by a condition of plantation to be by regularly you to
admit of no rights unless by the said plantation then it you
give such Rights and originally you to them as you are either
transported by you assigned to them that shall demand the profit
of the land and of plantation of this you
must take a special line from time to time

Fifthly You must be careful to delay no man who is
ought to be done and suffer not the Clerk under you to be
