

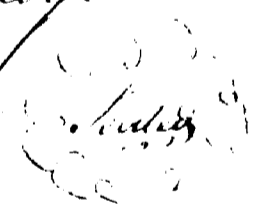
Secondly. And as I am not unawary you are to follow such  
directions as you shall receive from my Attorney Mr. Tho. Holley  
requiring you to write to me by all Opportunities from these parts  
Virginia the England or the York

Eightly You are strictly charged to take the results of the operations of  
all such Commanders and Masters of Ships or other lesser Vessels  
Coming into the mouth of the river shall not present Certificates  
from some Custom house in England of bond given there and  
to see that the same be broken observe the same Instructions and  
that Copies will of all such Bonds taken by you & the said  
Brokers of each Commanders and Masters as you shall be sent as  
I shall hereafter direct and appoint

Ninthly You are enjoined to sign Letters of the same nature  
to take the protest of will and sign warrants to Appraisers  
not omitting at the signing of such business by order and ap-  
pointment of the Honble Charles Calvert Esq.

Tenthly. Then you are required to cause all such Commanders  
and Masters as are bound to give bond with sufficient inhabitants  
of this Province for the performance hereof to sign all duties that the Law  
of this Province do require for them the part of such a Bond you  
may expect from Mr. Thomas Holley Given under my hand the  
fifteenth day of May one thousand six hundred sixty seven
