 Clerk of the Office to my Lord Baltimore to have purpose to see
 said Ridderwicke Bennet to execute the said Office of De
 puty Sheriff of the said Island as above said and to
 affix the impression of the seal of the Province to the said Order &
 to sign it by Order of the Deputy Lieut: and to deliver it to
 Robert Guntoles and to the said Bennet after he hath
 received therewith consent to the said Order given under
 my hand this 28th January 1669
