the Oath of one of his Lordships Council

Cidred that the Land by the water side and therewith
into the woods above Piscatorway be reserved and not surveyed
until ten thousand Acres be laid out for his Lordships use

Cidred that from the Thorehill to the degree forty
Northly Latitude be erected into a County and called by the
Name of Durham County and that from the Moorehill to
Mount Scarborough be likewise erected into a County & called
as the Lord Proprietary shall be apportioned

Cidred that Notice be given to the Sheriffs of Somerset
Pouchester Talbot & St. Battimore Countys that what person will
set any Land on the habourt side and Yelware Bay from
the Bounds of Virginia to the degree forty Northly Latitude
shall forthwith encouragement given by one Shillings per Acre
rent, whom such as fifty Acres which he or they shall
take up upon legal ministrance that the Surveyor General
doe charterize some person that he shall think fit to survey the
same and according to his Lordships former Order to lay out
for his Lordships use no manors in each County but three
now to containe six thousand Acres at the least

Cidred that the Surveyor General do make out the
Northly bounds of this Province as near as possible at the de-
gree forty Northly Latitude and return his Observations
to the Deputy Lieutenant in Council and that 100 T. Books
the Governor shew and be desirous to provide the Governors
Sloop with men and victuals for the accomodating the
Surveyor General up the Bay by the end of the month of
this instant month of October
