retaries thereunto belonging and to his seal and property thousands and five-
ties of the same. I will alsoe cause to performe execute and ex-
cuse all and every the Officer and Officers powerfull authorities Com-
Orders and directions relating to the Office and Officers Government
Committed or to be given and committed unto me by Charles Calvert
Esq: his Lordships Lieutenant and chief Governor for the time being
or by his Lordships amylawful Successor lawfully had and deserved
from his said Lordship. I will trulye and faithfullye and
Carefullye preserve and keep all the Records of or belonging
to the said Province or his said Lordship and such shall come
into my hands and property belonging unto or any the Office
or Offices and to my care and custodij so long as the same shall be
by his Lordships Lieut: Governor for the time being permitted to
remaine in my custody. I will not fraudulentlye wilfullye raze
deface alter change or Imborke or cause or procure to be fraudulentlye
or wilfullye razed defaced altered changed or Imborke the
said Records or any of them I will trulye and faithfullye keep
the Seal of the Province so long as the same shall be possessed by
