and to send his Lordship a true Copy of the said Records attes-
ted under your hand of such Manors as are already Reserved
as aforesaid as you shall find entered upon Record there in the
Office

7 That unless you see any part of his Lordships said
Instructions therein not hitherto observed or performed you
do thereunto immediately acquaint the Governor and Surveyor Ge-
neral there with any other of his Lordships Officers there
whom the speedy Redress of such faults do belong unto that you
do often remind them and press them to put the same in Exe-
cution and that you send his Lordship Notice from time to time
what is or shall be done therein

8 That you use all possible means to find out all such Lands
or Manors as having been formerly Reserved for his Lordships
Use are not as yet entered upon Record or if they be are not with-
standing imperfectly entered for want of distinct names and
Bounds assigned unto the same the quantities of Acres they contain
you are therefore in such Cases hereby required to cause all such Man-
ors reserved for his Lordships use to be named bounded and the
quantity of Acres they contain to be ascertained by his Lordships
Governor and Surveyor General or his Deputy or deputies there
and to be entered upon Record in your said Office and to send
a true Copy of all such Records of the said Manors unto his Lord-
ship attested under your hand and likewise to give his Lord-
ship particular notice from time to time of their proceedings as
well as your own therein

9 That you cause diligent search to be made into all conceal-
ments of any of his Lordships Rents or other yearly incomes
there and that you give notice thereof unto his Lordship &
