 Come greeting in our Lord God everlasting known by that whereby
 John Lederer Hamburgh born but now resident in Calvert
 County in the said Province of Maryland having formerly
 delivered several Nations of Indians to the South westward
 of this Province and requesting of me License to trade with
 them for Beaver and other Skins and also all other sorts of furs
 whatsoever that are to be found amongst the said Indians
 And we therefore to License and Authorize the said John Lederer
 to travel out of this Province such Tuck as he shall think most
 Convenient for the Trade of the said Indians and also to bring
 back into the said Province all such Skins Furs & other things
 as may be found amongst the said Indians & also to sell
 Cognacs, Hundreds, Liverworts, Mairrees, Gunpowder, Matches
 Sarsaparilla, Rukahokons, Higichies and other yes or of any other
 Nations of the South West Indians without let or molestation
 by any person what so ever and further to demand and require all
 persons whatsoever that if the said John Lederer ^{they} shall happen
 to meet with either travelling towards the said Several Nations
 of Indians to trade with them or returning back to the said Pro-
 vince of Maryland to permit him to pass quietly with such
 Commodityes as he shall have with him without let or molestation
 or hindrance what so ever provided always that his License to
 trade in anything thereon contained shall not extend to any power
 the said John Lederer to trade with any of the Neighbour Indians
 or to trade upon the said Province of Maryland nor with any
 Nation of Indians that inhabit within two hundred Miles of
 the said Province and further this License to Continue in force
 for the space of fourteen Years from the date hereof and no
