 County at Gay Whites Land and at William Berens Land on  
 Balls Creek in Talbot River in Calvert County at Charles  
 Town in the Lordships Townsight Humphrey Warrers in  
 the Potomac River and at the Land lately purchased by In<sup>o</sup>  
 England and Benjamin Rorer sight toward Lindsey in Port  
 Tobacco in Charles County At Richard Womers Land and at  
 Henrys Creek in An. Stundell County at the Land late of  
 Thomas Sumner in Bush River and at the Land late of  
 W<sup>o</sup> Mutton in Sassafras River in Baltimore County at  
 the Land of Jonathan Syber at the Mouth of Wye River  
 on the Eastern Side thereof at Conasa Creek in Chester River and  
 at Tadesons Creek in Choptank River in Talbot County  
 at Morgans Plantation in Weyans Creek in Kent County  
 at deep pond at Hundal Ponds in Somerset County and we  
 do hereby further order Ordain and declare that no masters  
 of Ships & Boats or other Vessels whatsoever coming hither for  
 Merchandizing or trade shall unload or put on shore any  
 Goods or Merchandizes what so ever in any other place harbor  
 or Creek within this Province until the said Goods or mer-  
 chandizes have been first delivered or put on shore at the ports  
 aforesaid or some of them upon the penalty of suffering one  
 whole Years Imprisonment without Bail or mainprize  
 any Fine wage or Custom to the contrary . . . . . notwithstanding  
 and if any Master of Ships & Boats or other Vessels  
 Merchants or other person or persons shall sell to any
