Now Soudships Instructions touching his manner of Chopin being perused and the Council being informed that Luke Barber deceased and John Pyle Gent have both of them taken up Land contrary to his Soudships said Instructions it was by the Board ordered that a *Writ facias* issue to the Sheriff of Saint Marys County to make known to John Blomfield who married the Relict of the said Barber and Luke Barber eldest Son of the said Barber to appear before this Board on the sixth of December next to show Cause if any they have why the said Luke Barbers Grants of the said Land should not be faciled upon Record and also to make known unto them that they bring with them all such papers patents and Escrips as they have in their possession relating to the said Land

It was also ordered that another *Writ facias* issue to the said Sheriff to make known unto the above named John Pyle that he be before this Board at the same time to show Cause &c and to bring with him *ut supra*

The said two *Writ facias* issued Accordingly ordered that the Clerk of the Council send to Mr Prousbey to Give him Notice to appear before the Board on the sixth of December next to inform the Board of his Request touching a parcel of Land surveyed formerly for Mr Richard Collet by Richard Fitzallen in Talbot County

The Board being informed that in a Certificate of Survey made by George Gates a deputy Surveyor in Annapolis County for one John Howell on the 17<sup>th</sup> of May 1670 there is a mistake in the said Certificate, <sup>viz. it is said in the said Certificate</sup> beginning at a wounded
