Captain Daniel Tenifer informing the Board that he was Appointed by the Act of Assembly for the keeping of the Standard for Saint Marys County and that he sent for weights measures and other things necessary for the same into England which are now come into this Province and that Mr Henry Heale by virtue of an Order of the Justices of the County Court hath taken the same into his Possession
