It is ordered by this Board that the Sheriff of Balti-
more County do pay unto the said Emerald Rutcliffe the Tobac-
co that remains in his hands due to the Lawyers that worked
upon the Fort the whole sum of just allotted them being four
thousand seven hundred and two pounds of Tobacco

And the Clerk of the Council is hereby ordered
before he deliver the Copy of this Order to the said Rutcliffe
to take Bond of the said Rutcliffe and one sufficient security
in the sum of Eight Thousand pounds of Tobacco upon Con-
dition that if any other person shall afterwards appear that
makes appear any right or Interest to any part of the said Tobac-
co allotted to the Lawyers as aforesaid that then the said Rut-
cliffe his heirs or Assigns shall satisfy such person or persons
their just dues out of the same
