It is ordered by this Board that the Sheriff of Baltimore County do pay unto the said Edward Ratcliffe the Tobacco or what amount in his hands due to the Lawyer that worked upon the suit the whole sum of four thousand four thousand seven hundred and two pounds of Tobacco.

And the Clerk of the Council whereby ordered before he deliver the Copy of this Order to the said Ratcliffe to take Bond of the said Ratcliffe and one sufficient security in the sum of eight Thousand pounds of Tobacco upon condition that if any other person shall appear and say that such person any right or interest being part of the said Tobacco so allotted to the Lawyer it is ordered that then the said Ratcliffe his heirs or assigns shall satisfy such persons or persons their just dues out of the same.
