Then was delivered unto his Excellency and Council his  
Excellency's warrant for the Surveying of the Ship John  
of Weymouth which followeth in these words viz:

Whereas William Harris Master of  
the Ship John of Weymouth and the rest of the said Ship  
Company have this day petitioned me for that whereas  
they shipped themselves on board the said Ship at the Port  
of Weymouth in the Kingdom of England about twelve months  
since bound for this Province and meeting with steps of wea-  
ther upon the Coasts of Virginia were forced to bear away for  
the Barbado's where unloading their Cargo..... they anew  
Laded with Barbado's Commodities and came for this Pro-  
vince and he arrived the seventh day of August last past  
and came to anchor in latitude 36<sup>o</sup> North where the said  
Ship videth to this day and for that the said Ship proving  
very leaky the said Master with the Carpenter and the  
rest of the Company of the said Ship did unbrag the  
Planks of the said Ship which they found to be much eaten  
with the worms and making a narrow search into the sides  
and Bottom of the said Ship found her so eaten with the  
worm that they think her not fitting to go to Sea and being  
afraid to venture for Weymouth back in her have in their  
said petition humbly besought me to grant an order to  
some Masters of Ships and their Carpenters to view the said
