

The duties thereof are paid according to the order of Assembly. Thereby allowing you a Reward for your repairs and trouble thereof. Out of the said Imposition Money Tonnage and Securities fees you to be accountable and make Payment of the Remainder to me upon demand provided always that you presume not to enter or Clear any decked Vessel whatsoever to have and to hold the said Office of Collector of the Imposition Money port duties and Securities fees during Pleasure Given under my hand and seal the 25<sup>th</sup> day of December in the 40<sup>th</sup> Year of the Dominion of Excellent Majesty William 1671

You shall Cause every such Undecked Vessel that shall Come  
to enter with you to enter into two Bonds with security that is to  
say the Bond of Navigation and the Bond of two shillings of which  
and also into one Bond for the Master of the said Vessel singly to  
be bounden for to be Obedient to the Laws of this Province

You shall demand an invoice of all such Goods and Mer-  
chandise they import into this Province the which with the  
Bond of Navigation you shall transmit to the Secretaries Office  
at Saint Wavy

When you have taken Bond of them as aforesaid you  
shall give them a License to trade signed by your self in my  
Name

When they Clear with you you must receive of them
