

of Worcester in the midst of the Province of Maryland Greeting in our
 Soul God lasting known ye that whereas his most excellent
 Majestie of I. Blesed memory Charles the first by the Grace of
 God King of England Scotland France and Ireland defender
 of the faith &c did by his Letters platters under the Seal
 of England bearing date the 26th day of June in the 8th
 Year of his Majesties Reign Anno Domini 1632 Grant unto
 us this Province of Maryland according to the bounds in
 the said Letters platters mentioned and expressed wherein
 his said Majestie of I. Blesed memory specified the bounds
 of our said Province to extend to the forteth degree of North
 Latitude and for that we have in our instructions several
 times to our Lieutenant and Council and more particularly
 in our Instructions bearing date the one and twentieth day
 of March One thousand six hundred sixty nine commanded
 Our Lieutenant and Council to use their utmost endeavours
 for the sealing of the said East Board side on the Eastern Shore
 the Whore Head and Delaware Bay to the forteth degree of North
 Latitude according to the bounds mentioned in the said
 Letters platters aforesaid and for that we are informed that
 several Persons are seated there without our Seaver License
 or without the Seaver license of our Captain General of our
 said Province and we having regard therof have
 Beginning at the Southernmost Branch of a Bay now called
 Melville Bay and from thence running Northly up the
 said Board side to the South Cape of Delaware and thence
 to the Whore Head Creek and up the Bay to the forteth degree
 Northly Latitude into a County and hereby erect the
 same into a County and it is our will and pleasure that it
 shall be a County and called by the name of Worcester County
 in our said Province of Maryland & we have appointed
 as well a commander of the forces in the said County
