 of March the thousand six hundred sixty nine well suf-
 ficiently manifested to show our further good will to
 the Inhabitants of our said County and to prevent their
 travelling to hunt Wapags to the Seculars Office to prove
 their rights and take old warrants for Land we have to that
 End and purpose employed Francis Tenbrunser an inhabi-
 tant and resident in the said County to do and perform
 the same in the said County witness our self at our City
 of Saint Marys the nineteenth day of June in the fourth
 year of our Dominion over our said Province one thousand
 six hundred seventy two
