Whereas his excellency the Captain Gen^l
 hath erected the Shore hill and Sea board side into a County
 by the name of Worcester County and there being no Clerks
 as yet appointed for the uttering of the Commissioners of
 the said County and requiring the Records thereof and Sir
 William Fulbot Baron and Principal Secretary of Maryland
 having empowered me fully for the deputing and Empowering
 all Clerks within this Province and being willing that
 the publick Business should not in any manner of ways
 be wanted or delayed for want of a Clerk and myself
 being wholly unacquainted with the Inhabitants of those
 parts do hereby authorize and Empower you Thomas Jones
 Gent one of the Justices of the same County to depu^t &
 appoint such person as to you shall seem meet to be
 Clerk of the same County and I shall signify the contrary
