Whereas his Excellency the Captain Genl  
hath created the Horehead and Seaboard side of a County  
by the name of Worcester County and there being no Clerk  
as yet appointed for the Administration of the Commissioners of  
the said County and Keeping the Records thereof and Sir  
William Talbot Baronet Principal Secretary of Maryland  
having empowered me fully for Judging and Empowering  
all Clerks within this Province and being willing that  
the publick business should not in any manner of way  
be retarded or delayed for want of a Clerk and myself  
being wholly unacquainted with the Inhabitants of those  
parts do hereby authorize and empower you Thomas Jones  
Gent one of the Justices of the same County to depute &  
appoinne such person as to you shall seem meete to be  
Clerk of the same County until I shall signify the contrary
