 deceare the said said planters of the said Imposition of
 two shillings per hhd. to take away several considerable quantities
 of tobacco up to the head of the Bay and thence transport
 the same by land into delaware River and never make
 Payment of the Imposition aforesaid but defraud his lord
 ship thereof and wheras his Lordship hath affwnted me
 his Receiver General of the plantece as well to receive that
 Imposition money as other his lordships dues by my self
 or officer appoynted for that purpose and I reposing esse
 et luctu and confidence in the honestyness and Integrity of
 Thomas Carleton Genl Captayn Sheriff of the said County do
 hereby Authorize and command the said Thomas Carleton to
 be his lordships collector of the said Imposition money
 under me for all such Tobacco as shall be transported by
 the head of the Bay into delaware River and the said
 Imposition money of all plantece that transport Tobacco
 the way aforesaid to receive and in case of their Refusal to
 pay him, to proceede as the said act of Assembly to the intent
 of his lordships collector by way of Seizure or otherwise
 provided the said Captain Carleton shall twice every
 year at the least tender me an account what he shall ha
 ve received aforesaid and this plantece to be done in force to
 the said Carleton until I shall signify the contrary
 under my hand and no longer Given under my hand
 and seal this 23rd day of October in the fourty
 first year of the Dominion of Cecilius & Anney Dom
 1679
