Forty three in John Lichington Master of the Ship
Mary of London when he made ready of the said Ship did
procure Garrett Karsveeungen of the City of Flamburgh
holder to his security as well for his payment of the Provo
ntion and for his due discharge for such Voyage which should transport
out of this Province as also to be bound with him according
to the Act of Parliament for increase of Shipping and Navigation
and for that John Dugley Partner with the said Garrett
hath this day on the behalf of the said Garrett informed me that
the said John Lichington hath absented himself from the said
Ship and is gone into Hispania and as he supposeth intends to
have the Ship brought thither after him and so never intendeth
to steer in this Province whereby the said Garrett Karsveeungen
may come to be liable to . . . the penalty of the Bond entered
into by him only out of Kindness to the said Lichington which
Bond was for twelve hundred pounds Sterling and should the
whole penalty come to fall upon the said Garrett it would be
to his use and for the speedy prevention whereof these are
in the name of the right honble the Lord Proprietary to will
and command you immediately to goon Board the said
Ship and to seize and secure the said Lichington & them cause
