 unto mee in y^e signs upon demand provided always
 that you presume not by virtue of this Order to enter or Clear
 any deaden Vessels whatsoever and always provided that you
 return unto me with all convenient speed the several Bonds
 of Navigation you shall take from the respective Vessels. you
 shall enter and Clear as aforesaid. I hereby allowing you
 for your labour and pains in the execution of the premises ten
 Cent out of the Imposition money port duties and Secreta
 ries fees given under my hand and Seal at Arms this fiveth
 twentieth day of October in the two and fortieth year of the
 Dominion of Charles the first King of Great Brittain One thousand six
 hundred seventy three.
