Whereas I did by a Commission under my hand and Seal of Office bearing date the 23 day of December in the 39<sup>th</sup> year of the dominion of Cecilius &c. my power and authorize you William Stevens and James Heeden of the County of Somerset Gent. Jointly or severally to prove rights to land grant Conditional Warrants or Warrants for land upon rights before you or either of you as aforesaid of your proceedings in which Affairs you were to transmit an account and a Copy of what you had so done by every convenient opportunity and for that several Commissions are made that lands hath by warrants by you or one of you granted been Surveyed and the Certificates already returned to my Office
