

That we do hereby authorise you and your son to be appointed to the said

I have now done hereby authorise you in case you shall find it necessary to appoint
Constitutes any other person or persons not exceeding the Number of three persons to be of
our Privy Council and to be Judges and Justices of our Provincial Court of our
said Province together with those persons by us already appointed to it of our said Council
and to be Judges and Justices of our said Court, and the person and persons so by you to
be appointed and Constituted to cause to be sworn of our said Council and to be
sworn Justices of our said Court which said person and persons so by you to be
appointed and Constituted we do hereby appoint and Constitute to be of our said
Privy Council and to be Judges and Justices of our said Court during our absence
as fully and amply to all intents and purposes as if they had been or were specially
appointed and Constituted ab sine by our self under our hand so ab hoc et hinc tali
the oath and oaths appointed to be taken in such cases by us who are of our said
Council and by us who are Judges and Justices of our said Court before he or they
shall exercise or execute the said Office or Offices, so where they shall be so appointed
Constituted.

I have now done hereby require and strictly enjoin you to cause frequent Meetings to be
made of all the several Trained Bands Soldiers and Militia of our said Province
within the several and respective Counties of our said Province so often as will
convene the same may be, and get all persons capable of bearing Arms may be
trained up to be used and Exercise of Arms, and get all necessary Masters to be
enjoined to furnish themselfs with sufficient Arms and Ammunition forthcoming
and all instruments capable of bearing Arms and to have the same always in
Readiness and upon sound of Trumpet or beat of Drum to appear at all times for the
Defence of our said Province, and of themselves and their Country and fortunes and
in this we do more particularly require your Diligence in regard of the same
wards Ireland as the English Nation in all parts by the former King and the
United Kingdom of the Netherlands and for the particular care and Indemnity whereof
we have for the security and safety of the people of our said Province.

I have that you give Directions particularly to our first Principal Secretary of our said
Province to be same Effect at formerly we directed you to do to Henry Trevelyan
our late Principal Secretary in Relation to the strict and due Entries of Bills of Lading
and taking bonds of shippes coming to our said Province and in Relation to shippes
Trading in our said Province, and to mind the aforesaid instructions to be in all points
closly observed, taking care to return copies of the said bonds at formerly you sent up by the
our Directions to do.

I have that you do deliver with your own hands unto our dear Brother Philip
Pelham Esq our great Seal of our said Province, and Convey him unto him the said
aforesaid unto his person by us appointed to be Conveyed unto and taken by
the Chancellor of our said Province, upon his taking of the said oath and the delivery
of which said Seal unto him will do hereby Constitute and Ordain him to be
Chancellor of our said Province and we do hereby direct authorise and appoint you
to demand him to be so accordingly, and we do hereby declare that the Chancellor of our said
Province by us or our Lieutenant of our said Province for the time being or his sufficient
Duly or Deputy in his absence and by our pleasure and Express direction and
