

Marchants and Seamen their factors and Agents, and to all of any other neighbouring
plant Colonies provinces and plantations whatsoever, small towns and particularly
in all cases where they or shall relate unto Runaway servants or slaves.

I command you to be carefull to print and certify and to cause and procure to be a Proclamation
and Rectified, the Seiner Bulles and usall Tolls and Duties in Bills of Lading —
and other papers and writings of Marchants and Seamen touching Tobacco of the
growth of our said Province namely that all such Tobacco be in all such Bills papers
and writings sealed and written by her name of Maryland Tobacco, and that it may
publicly passe, and be called and knowne by her name of Maryland Tobacco
and not by her name of Virginia Tobacco, or Bay Tobacco or by any other name
or name whatsoever.

I command you consider upon a way how we may be freed of her loyalty and fidelity
of such persons as by Reason of their dissatisfaction touching the lawfulness of
taking of oaths cannot be prevailed with, to take the oath of fidelity By requiring
such persons to give security to performe the substance of the said oath of fidelity
by becoming bound for each other, And that you do with as much speede as the
circumstances of affayre will allow and desir of you in Execution
by taking or causing such security to be taken.

I command you and every of you in your respective places and according to your
severall powers do up all possible means you can have, Paying, collecting
and exacting of our debts and dues, and of all the Clerks and Clerks
thereof and for the future strict and carefull exacting and collecting of all
all manner of Rent Dutys, and in particular of Rent Dutys of and from and
upon all and all manner of shippes and vessels coming or trading or hereafter
to come or trade in or to any place or places within our said Province of Dominions —

Or in particular in or upon Patowmack River or any of thereof, after all on East side of the said
said River where Runneth over border with upon Virginia, as on East side of the said river which
which runneth over border with upon our said Province of Maryland, and for the payment of the
payment of the same, into the hands of our Justices or Clerks General to be
executed by us or our said Clerks for our use.

I command you consider by all the ways and means you can touchyng the finding
out and appointing a certeine competent Number of particular places in or upon
the severall and respective Rivers of our said Province most convenient for
loading and forighting unloading and disburdening of shippes and farringe
goods and dryg, so the end we may appoint a certeine competent Number
of certeine and fitted shippes in every such River for the benefit of Trade and
for the safe and securitie of Marchants in this way of Trade, with exclusion her
all other places and with an express prohibition to all persons to load or unload
any ship or vessel Marchant or Merchant in any other place or places
within our Province aforesaid, and that you signify unto us with all
convenient speed your Judgements opinion in Relation to her same.

I command before the Execution of any the Officers persons authority and Commission
by us now lately given granted or confirmed or directed to be granted
given or confirmed to or upon you our Lieutenant Generall (named
principal Secretary officer of State or Governor or in Relation to the
Administration of Justice in our Provinciale parts you do all of you further
