

In the month and oaths respectively by us directed to be taken by and Administered unto a certain
 singular just respective Officers of State Government or Justice respectively, whereof we
 do hereby authorize and appoint you our said Lieutenant General to give and
 Administer such oaths and oaths unto our said Dear Brother as are by our order
 and appoint to be Administered unto and taken by our honorable of our said
 Province, and unto such as we to fit and be of our said Privy Council, and likewise
 such oaths as we have directed to be Administered to our Judges Justices or Commissioners
 of our said Provinciaall Court and we do hereby likewise authorize our said Dear
 Brother after he shall have been so sworn at aforesaid and shall have taken
 the said oaths and respective oaths hereby appointed to be Administered unto
 him at aforesaid to give and Administer unto our said Dear Brother such oaths and
 oaths as it and are by our order and appoint to be Administered unto and taken
 by our Lieutenant General there. And also such as by like order and appoint
 are now by us directed to be and taken by such as by our Authority are
 appointed and authorized to sit and be Judges Justices or Commissioners of our said
 Provinciaall Court. And also to give and Administer unto our said Principall
 Secretary such oaths as by our order and appoint to be Administered unto or
 taken by our said Principall Secretary of our said Province, and also to give and
 Administer unto our said Principall Secretary and all others ordained constituted
 or appointed by us to be of our privy Council or of the privy Council to
 our Lieutenant General and to sit and be Judges and Justices of our said Court such
 particular and respective oaths and oaths as by our appoint and order to be
 Administered unto and taken by such as we or shall choose or appoint by us to
 be of our privy Council there, and also such oaths and oaths as are by us
 directed to be Administered unto and taken by such as we have appointed and
 authorized to sit as Judges Justices or Commissioners of our said Provinciaall Court.
 You that you seriously take into your consideration to find and speedily to
 propose unto us some convenient way of and for the making of some visible
 distinction and distinction between you our Lieutenant General our honorable
 Principall Secretary, Lieutenant Officers Councils Judges Justices and
 the rest of the people of our said Province either by the wearing of habits
 maddally or otherwise.
 You we do further direct order and appoint by these presents that if at
 any time in our absence from our said Province our Lieutenant General of
 our said Province for the time being shall happen to die without having
 power from us to appoint some person or persons to succeed him in the exercise
 or execution of the said Office and the powers thereto belonging or without
 appointing some person or persons to succeed him at aforesaid that in all and
 every such case and cases happening it shall and may be lawful and we do
 hereby authorize and give power unto our privy Council of our said Province
 for the time being to elect and appoint some person or persons of our Council
 for the time being, and residing in or to our Province to exercise and execute the
 Office of Lieutenant General and Chief Governor of our said Province until we or
 our heirs or assignees and proprietaries Lords or proprietaries of the
 said
