 appear before me at the City of St Marys the Tenth day of December next and
 bring with them such Licenses as they have by virtue of whiche they keep ordinary
 or some Testimonials from the Quisitors of the County where they live that they
 are persons fitting to keep ordinary, and so take out new Licenses, and enter into such
 Recognizance at the Court of this Province doe enjoye, or else to proclaim that we
 doe hereby vacate the said Licenses to them formerly granted, and shall proceed ag-
 gainst them as persons that sell Drinke and keep ordinary without License, Given under
 my hand and seale at Shrewsbury the fifth day of October in the 4th year of the
 Dominion of the Right honorable Cecilus of Annoy Domini 1672.
