Hovemur ab I have granted libertie to severall persons within this Province for the keeping of
a publicke Ordinary whiclh libertie was extreame to only a year, to kepe
Ordinary and then to be voyd, and for that I am informed that severall persons in the
Ripperhie Countye of this Province doe presume to kepe ordinary notwithstanding
havⁿ no libertie, or else their libertie are voyd and out of Date.

I therefore command you that you make publicke proclamation thorow
your Districke that all persons that kepe any publicke Ordinary within the same
Either by vertue of any libertie from me, or without any libertie at all doe presently
appear before me at the Citye of St Marys the Thirteenth day of December next and
bring with them just libertie as they have by vertue of whiche they kepe ordinary
or some Testimoniall from the Sheriffes of the Countye where they live testify
an person fitting to kepe ordinary, and so take out new libertie, and enter into full
Recouerance ab the Laws of this Province doe enjoye, or else to proclaime that we
do hereby vacate the said libertie to them formerly granted, and shall proceed ag
them ab persons that still kepe and kepe ordinary without excuse, Given under
my hand and seal at Annes the fifth day of October in the 41st year of the
Dominion of the Right hon^{ble} Cecilius Lord Somers 1672.
