 paines of penalty in the Law against transporting frow Indian out of this
 Province provided and ordained.

The Councill orde Proclamation to shew to satisfy all people that if they are
 any waye prejudiced or damaged by the miscarriage of the Esq^r Surveyor if they doe
 not seeke for Reparation in five monthes time after such miscarriage is Comitted
 the person that is so prejudiced to be left Remedied, against the Surveyor General or
 his Deputy. five monthes from the Date of this Proclamation for what is
 already done and five monthes from the time that his injury is done afterward.

 belonging and appertaining to y^e said office to the said Deputy's owne use without
 being accountable for y^e same to any person from the fourth day of September last
 untill and during his time at he shall execute the same and for his so doing ther
 shall be his sufficient warrant Given under my hand and seal at com^{ts} this 25th
 day of April in the 41th year of the Dominion of Philip of Spanoye Province 1643.
