And I do further Swear, that I will in all things and upon all Occasions, doe right & justice to all manner of people Rich and poor according to the Lawes and usages of this Province and the utmost of my Skill and Judgm<sup>t</sup>. without favour or affection hatred or malice to any person or persons what so ever; and I will in all things to the utmost of my power observe performe, maintaine and keep and cause to be observed performed, maintaine and kept in all things One certaine act of an Assembly made in the ninth year of his said Majesty's Dominion Over this Province intituled An Act concerning Religion and all the other articles and clauses therein contained w<sup>o</sup>ut doing or willfully consenting unto or countenancing the doing of any act or thing which may directly or Indirectly tend to the infringing or violating the same or any part thereof.
